### Kimbilio Prayer news May 2026

Clement sends his greetings and has sent over the latest news from the project. Please share these updates with your congregations

1. Thank god for the reintegration of 14 year old Kabange. In 2018, six-year-old Kabange was brought 272 kilometers from Kasenga and left at a market in Lubumbashi. Kimbilio welcomed him into the day centre and later the Boys' Transit Centre. At the time, Kabange faced severe health and communication difficulties. After eight years of care, support, and stability at Kimbilio, his speech improved, and he expressed a wish to find his family. On May 7th, staff members Patrick and Élisé traveled with him. Thanks to Kabange remembering his father's name, they were able to locate his family 35 kilometers outside of Kasenga, where he received a very warm welcome.
2. With the Easter holidays over, please pray for the children as they return to their classrooms. We hope they can focus well, enjoy their lessons, and find motivation in their education
3. Funding is still needed to finish building the technical school. Please keep the fundraising efforts and construction work in your prayers.
4. We pray for the next intake for the Young Mums' training program and hope these courses can proceed smoothly.
5. We pray that next year's new series of training courses will be offered to young men aged 18 and older. The goal is to help them step away from difficult environments, negative peer groups, and substance issues by giving them a practical alternative.
6. Please continue to pray for the wider Democratic Republic of Congo, hoping for stability and peace across the country.
